What happens during CS Classes

Here's the reality: AI tools are getting smarter, generating ideas within seconds. So the advantage is no longer just having ideas. It's knowing what to do with them when things get messy, people are involved, and not everything goes as planned.

In CS class, students take on different roles to plan and run real events:



Understand the **purpose** and **impact** behind what they are creating.



Build teams where everyone **knows their role** and **takes ownership**.



Communicate, lead, and work through challenges as they happen.



Create **marketing and content** that actually gets people interested.



Manage **budgets and resources** in a responsible, thoughtful way.



Reflect on what worked [and what didn't] to improve next time.

This is where ideas are tested, adjusted, and brought to life.



Developing far more than skills

Through the Creative Skills (CS) programme, students learn to think on their feet, adapt when things change, and stay steady when situations get challenging. They begin to take ownership of their work – not because they are told to, but because they understand their contribution matters.

Over time, this builds confidence rooted in experience (not theory!), along with the ability to work with others, lead when needed, and follow through on what they started.
